Business Arising from the Minutes

Continuing Business

Response to Application for J-Class Roads Cost-Sharing Program for Paving for the 2024-25 Fiscal Year

Mr. Horne provided an update on changes to the last draft of the capital plan. All three of the J-Class Road applications submitted by the County were denied. Discussion followed.

ICIP Project Updates

There were no questions regarding the ICIP updates that were summarized in the memo included with the agenda package.

New Business

Cape George Lighthouse Road Request

Councillor MacLellan spoke to a request received by the organization maintaining the Cape George Lighthouse, asking for assistance or relief from the municipality for the maintenance of the roadway by means of the municipality assuming the roadway. Mr. Horne noted that previous requests have been responded to noting that if the road is brought to municipal standards, consideration would be given to the



municipality assuming the road. Deputy Warden MacFarlane suggested sending an Engineer to get an estimate on the cost to bring the roadway up to municipal standards. Consensus was given for staff to do so.

Mount Cameron Sidewalk Request

Councillor MacDonald spoke to a request brought forward by a resident requesting consideration of the municipality installing a sidewalk along Mount Cameron Circle from the intersection with Highway 337 to the Town boundary line, which is a distance of about 255 feet. Installing this short stretch of sidewalk would provide better connectivity of pedestrian infrastructure in a high traffic area. The suggestion to request that an Engineer provide an estimate for this proposal as well. Consensus was given for staff to do so.

Additions to the Agenda

Cape George Day Park

Councillor MacLellan provided Council with an update regarding concerns brought to her with respect to the province not maintaining the Cape George Day Park, even though it is newly named as a Provincial Park. The maintenance arrangement at Arisaig Provincial Park was shared as a comparison, and Councillor MacLellan noted that she has not had any success with reaching anyone from the Department of Natural Resources to be able to discuss maintenance arrangements for Cape George. Councillor MacLellan noted that since the park was announced to be a Provincial Park, visitor numbers have tripled, increasing the burden on the local volunteers who are trying to maintain the facilities. Staff was directed to send a letter to the Province to express the concerns raised about the park maintenance. Councillor McNamara shared his experience with meeting with the Minister of Natural Resources and MLA Morrow at the Cape Jack Park.

RE: COST SHARE AGREEMENT 2023-002 ON THE PAVING OF SUBDIVISION (J CLASS) STREETS

The Department of Public Works expects to fund, subject to budget approval, the paving, repaving, and double chipping of Subdivision streets during the 2025-26 construction season.

Cost sharing, regardless of type of treatment (paving, repaving, or double chip), will be fifty per cent for eligible streets (50/50).

As per section 3.1 of the agreement, the Municipality must provide notice to the Province on or before October 31, 2024.

Attached, you will find a Road Submission List to be filled out electronically and returned to me electronically by October 31, 2024.

Examples of how to fill out the form is provided. Due to funding limitations, please limit your priorities to a maximum of ten candidates <u>and please put these in order of priority</u>. If any of the columns are not filled in, the list will be rejected by the Province and you will be asked to re-submit.

The submitted streets will be reviewed to verify eligibility and to determine if the condition of the proposed streets meets the minimum criteria for paving, repaving, or double chip.

Please submit this information to <u>my attention via email</u> to ensure your list will be considered for the upcoming fiscal year.

Please consider your Municipality's fiscal funding limitations when preparing your list and limit the list to only the projects the Municipality intends to fund in fiscal 2025-26.

Smith Way Request

S.F. Smith Developments is requesting the addition of a sidewalk along Smith Way in Mount Cameron. The distance is a total of 151.8m or 498ft. See attached a picture showing the distances marked up on the drawing showing the 2 sections of 72.50m and 79.3m totalling 151.8m.

Considerations

The cost of a sidewalk can vary from approximately \$400-\$550 per meter based on the need for curb and buffer (top soil and seed).
