Mount Cameron Rezoning

Ms. MacGillivray-Case spoke to the status of the motion that was tabled on October 8, 2024, as well as a second motion regarding that tabled motion made on November 12, 2024. Councillor Baden-Clay provided his thanks to the residents in his district that reached out to him to express their concerns with the proposed development, with particular mention of the loss of a walking trail located where a road is proposed to be constructed, and the potential for flooding of adjacent properties adjacent to the proposed development. Councillor Baden-Clay that a request be made to the applicant to provide a stormwater management plan. He noted that many of the residents that reached out to him asked for an additional access to Highway 337, which is shown in the proposed development plan. He also spoke to representatives from Public Works regarding sewage treatment plant concerns when investigating the concerns raised by residents in that area. Councillor Baden-Clay noted that senior's housing is in high demand in the community and asked that affordable housing be a consideration in development in the area. He asked that municipal policies regarding parkland dedication be revisited, as well as the means that are utilized for giving notice of a rezoning application to the public, and that accessibility and active transportation be considered as well.
